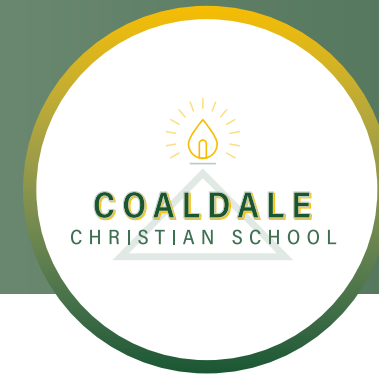

Throughout this program you will see numerous ads from businesses in and around Coaldale. This is just a small taste of the wonderful community of Coaldale and serves to show the fantastic support

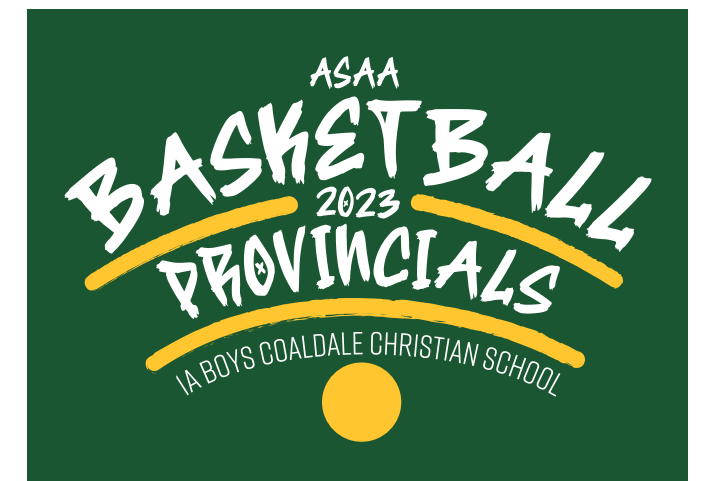
we have received from local businesses and from the Town of Coaldale. This event would not be what it is without their amazing support. Thank you!!
